

PUBLIC HEARING

LORAIN COUNCIL CHAMBERS - CITY HALL BLDG. - LORAIN, OH, FEBRUARY 11, 2019

President Arredondo called the public hearing to order at 6:03 p.m. Deputy Clerk Dull announced the public hearing was called to discuss the request to change the name of “All Pro Athletic Avenue” to “Silver Maple Way” in the City of Lorain. This hearing was published and owners were notified, all in accordance with state statutes.

Notice of the public hearing was published in the local newspaper in accordance with state statutes and abutting property owners were notified of this hearing by mail.

REMARKS: PRESIDENT ARREDONDO: Who is here representing All Pro Athletic Avenue?

JASON COE, Director of Operations, Silver Maple Recovery: I appreciate your consideration. Do you have any questions about the name change or anything?

COUNCILMAN THORNSBERRY: I have heard no complaints. It is not in my ward but I am right on the border of it though. I would like you to take back to your group if you could please just some issues we have been having with the parking situation over there, more so on the other side. I don't know how long you have been involved with the project but people are used to parking on what is your side now when there is a lot of events going on over on the sports side and since this changeover there are still people parking over there. I don't even know if that is allowed or if they are supposed to be parking there but we are hearing complaints of very dangerous conditions in the parking lot there.

MR. COE: In that parking lot?

COUNCILMAN THORNSBERRY: Yes. They are not doing a lot of plowing like they used to or salting and things like that. There was an email that I was tagged on from a couple of residents that it was sent to Chris Dore on the sports side so I just wanted you guys to be aware of that as well. As far as the name change on the street I have heard no complaints.

COUNCILWOMAN SPRINGOWSKI: I haven't heard any complaints either and if we could have appropriate signage clearing indicating that that is parking for that facility only that might help out a little bit with regards to that.

MR. COE: Sure, okay.

COUNCILMAN FALLIS: I think it is certainly appropriate to change the name to the street being that there is a new business and function there so I am in favor of this change. I appreciate your investment in our city.

MR. COE: Thank you.

PRESIDENT ARREDONDO: Any other comments from council? There being none, at this time I will open it up to the public. Any comments from the public come to the mic and state your name.

There being no further comments, the public hearing was adjourned at 6:07pm.
