The Chairman stated in a memo in September 2009 that any recommendations from the committees are to come before the Board of Directors in separate, individual recommendations, not as a committee. The committee will have no voting or consensus power.

The Proposal & Justification Committee shall first ascertain that the applicant request for either financial, and or technical assistance has filled all of the necessary forms, and that they are completed as required, and any other obligation assigned by a majority of the Board. The Committee has the authority to require that additional forms be completed that it deems are necessary before allowing the request to come before the full Board for consideration. The committee will from time to time report to the full board as requested by the TURA Chair.

The Contract Committee will monitor TURA contracts for compliance with the contract, make recommendations concerning payments to the applicant if applicable, and generally oversee the completion of the contract requirements, and any other obligation assigned to it by a majority of the Board. The committee will from time to time report to the full TURA Board as requested by the TURA Chair.

The Streetscapes Committee was formed to search out possible improvements to a test area between the streets, from 2nd to 3rd, on Main Avenue. The test area was later changed due to the ODOT intersection project and the improvements to sidewalks on Main and Pacific Avenues. ~~Some, but not all, of the issues the committee is to address in making a recommendation to the full Board will be blade signs, hanging baskets, flower boxes, trash containers, colors to be recommended for facades and signs, sidewalk improvements, informational signs, street directional signs at the entrances to the downtown area. In short any issue that can improve the "open for business" atmosphere, or the "stop and walk a bit with us" idea. This committee will also work in conjunction with the City's Beautification Committee and the TRA.~~
