RE: Skid steer purchase

I am attaching the bid from Pacific JCB for **\$119,871.40** that includes the price of the skid steer for \$79,830.40, the trade value of the fork lift \$8,000.00, and all the additional options for \$48,041.00.

We have \$120,000 budgeted in the upcoming 2020-2021 Budget in Water Fund Capital.

The skid steer will be used to replace the JCB tell all fork lift, which is being used for trade in. With the needs to get into smaller work spaces such as Tillamook's narrow road ways, this equipment is smaller and turns tight so it will require less room maneuvering. It is on tracks so it can be on soft ground, and off roadways. Attachments can easily be switched, and there is a number of attachments available, such as a brush mower, asphalt grinders for street repairs, stump grinders that could be used in the parks, and debris clamp for homeless camp cleanup. We can also purchase other attachments in the future as our needs change.

If this is approved, I will start the process to purchase this equipment after the new fiscal year.
