Please know by this email that Section 2 of the ratified Emergency Declaration of May 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020 is hereby amended as follows:

“Park areas, including playground equipment areas, outdoor sports courts, skate parks, are now open to the public, subject to the required guidance of the Governor’s Executive Order. Restrooms will remain closed. The guidance that day use areas such as picnic tables observe social distancing guidelines between different parties also remains in effect.”

Additionally, the Emergency Declaration of June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2020 is hereby amended as follows:

“The City-wide State of Emergency continues to exist within the City of Tillamook, and therefore, this State of Emergency shall be extended until July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020, unless further extended or rescinded by the City Council.”
