RATIFICATION OF AN EMERGENCY DECLARATION, AUGMENTATION AND AMENDMENT

(DATED JULY 6, 2020)

OF A TEMPORARY STATE OF EMERGENCY WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY AND PROVIDING GUIDELINES FOR THE REOPENING OF OUTDOOR RECREATION

WHEREAS, the date of conclusion of the State of Emergency declared in the City of Tillamook Updated Emergency Declaration dated April 6, 2020, and all provisions thereof, have been augmented on June 2, 2020 and extended until the end of day on June 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on June 11, 2020 the Governor allowed for jurisdictions operating within Phase 2 of the Oregon phased coronavirus reopening plan to allow for the reopening of certain Outdoor Recreation facilities, and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Manager retains all rights to provide guidance during a State of Emergency, and declared, on June 19, 2020, the extension of a State of Emergency and the reopening of certain park facilities until such time as the City Council met to ratify those decisions.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TILLAMOOK DOES HEREBY FIND AND RATIFY:

1. **City-wide State of Emergency.** It is hereby ratified that existing conditions are such that the City-wide State of Emergency continues to exist within the City of Tillamook; therefore, this State of Emergency shall be extended to continue until July 31, 2020, unless further extended or rescinded by the City, or representatives retaining authority to act therefrom.

2. **Outdoor Facilities Reopening:** It is hereby ratified that park area, including playground equipment areas, outdoor sports courts, and skate parks, are now open to the public, subject to the required guidance of the Governor's Executive Order. Public restrooms at these facilities are to remain closed until such time as it is determined that they may reopen. The guidance regarding day-use areas, including picnic tables, and the usage of physical distancing guidelines between different parties, continues to remain in effect.
