

**INTRAGOVERNMENTAL MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BY AND BETWEEN
THE KNOX COUNTY COMMISSION,
THE MAYOR OF KNOX COUNTY
AND
THE KNOX COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION,
THE SUPERINTENDENT OF KNOX COUNTY SCHOOLS**

THIS INTRAGOVERNMENTAL Memorandum of Understanding and Agreement is made and entered into this 1st day of December, 2019 among Knox County, a political subdivision of the State of Tennessee, a Home Rule Public Corporation and Charter Government and its elected entities, Knox County Commission, the Mayor of Knox County and the Knox County Board of Education, and the Superintendent of Knox County Schools.

NOW, THEREFORE the parties do hereby mutually agree as follows:

Moving Central Office Locations

Knox County Board of Education agrees to relocate Central Office from the Andrew Johnson Building to the TVA East Tower. Knox County Government will use proceeds to offset buildout cost of floors P-6. Additionally, Knox County Government will pay all buildout costs associated with the TVA East Tower, and cover moving expenses.

Operating Costs

Knox County Board of Education will incur no operating costs associated with TVA East Tower for the initial 15-year term, thus allowing Knox County Board of Education to redirect funds to student needs.

If after the initial term, Knox County Board of Education and Knox County Government agree to exercise the five options available to stay in the TVA East Tower, this agreement will continue to be enforceable unless either party bring it up for amendment.

Wherefore, the parties, having passed the appropriate resolution, set their hands this ___ day of _____, 2019.
