**Forensic Interviews**

Of the total 207 Forensic Interviews provided in the third quarter, 24 were for children from Leander:

- 16 females and 8 males;
- 3 in the 0-5 range; 6 in the 6-11 range; and 15 in the 12-17 range.
- Our Multidisciplinary Team (MDT) reviewed 5 Leander cases this quarter.

### Family Advocacy

Our Family Advocate meets with families in crisis to offer support, education and referrals to needed social services. Our advocate provided Victim Advocacy and Crisis Intervention for 17 Leander families who accompanied children who were interviewed.

### Medical Exams

Of the 24 children interviewed from Leander, 5 of them received additional services by a trained forensic nurse.

### Counseling Services

A total of 92 counseling sessions were provided to Leander clients (comprised of child victims, their siblings and their non-offending parents) for this quarter.

### Community Outreach

Our child abuse specialist educates those who have primary access to children in how to recognize the signs and symptoms of child abuse and how to respond. Our Outreach Coordinator conducted 4 trainings with 68 participants from Leander.

We appreciate the dedication of the Leander PD, and their willingness to bring children to the WCCAC. We are excited for the year to come and look forward to our ongoing working relationship with Leander.
