

NUECES COUNTY RURAL RAIL TRANSPORTATION DISTRICT

DUTIES:

To utilize and improve rail systems for economic benefit in Nueces County. The Rural Rail District would be eligible to qualify for private, state, and federal funds in order to develop the infrastructure necessary to assure the most efficient and economical movement of essential agricultural products from the areas of production to the local, national, and export markets.

COMPOSITION:

The board shall consist of at least seven members to be appointed by the Commissioners Court of Nueces County. Vacancies, as they occur, shall be filled by appointment of Commissioners Court. March 17, 2010 Commissioners Court approved increasing the board from five (5) to seven (7).

CREATION & AUTHORITY:

Established by Commissioners Court on May 23, 2001, Volume 32, Page 759 of Commissioners Court Minutes in accordance with the provisions of Article 6550c, Vernon's Annotated Texas Civil Statutes. An Order was adopted under this section and was placed in the minutes of Commissioners Court meeting of June 27, 2001, Volume 32, Page 808.

MEETS:

The board shall meet monthly or as deemed necessary.

TERMS:

Seven directors appointed for terms of two years. Terms expire on the second anniversary of the date of appointment.
