It is a privilege to provide you and the Nueces County Commissioners Court this report on the use of the grant of \$700 for the 2012-2013 fiscal year which ended ~~June 30, 2013.~~ ✓

Between July 1, 2012 and June 30, 2013 our chapter and its volunteers responded to more than 90 disaster assistance requests, most the result of home fires and more than half of those occurred in Nueces County. Over 370 residents in our area, 194 from Nueces County, were victims of those disasters and received direct assistance from the chapter as well as referrals to other agencies to ensure our victims had opportunities for assistance with their long-term recovery.

We spent more than \$46,000 in support of disaster victims, including more than \$19,000 in Nueces County and were exceedingly glad for the support you provided. More than 30% of our clients had annual family incomes less than \$20,000, one-third were younger than 18 years of age, over half were women and 46% were Hispanic, based on the reports we have. Eighty percent did not have insurance and almost that same percentage had no emergency plan.

We are indeed grateful for the support given by you and the Commissioners Court, which has helped us remain ready and responsive to the needs of our fellow citizens at critical times in their lives.
