## AGREEMENT AMENDMENT NO. 1

**WHEREAS**, the County of Nueces and Martin Marietta Materials entered into an Agreement on October 23, 2013, for Aggregate Type PB, Grade 4, LRA (Limestone Rock Asphalt); IFB No. 2938-13;

**WHEREAS**, the parties now want to exercise the option as set out in Article II of the Agreement to extend the term of the Agreement;

**WHEREAS**, Martin Marietta Materials is requesting a price escalation for this item as set out in Article I of the Agreement;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, Nueces County and Martin Marietta Materials, in consideration of the mutual agreements contained in the original Agreement and additional time provided pursuant to this amendment do hereby mutually agree:

1. To exercise the renewal option of 12 months as set out in Article II of the Agreement extending the termination date of the Agreement to October 23, 2015.
2. To increase cost for this item by 7.2% by giving County 30 day written notice as set out in Article I of the Agreement. The item cost increase is to be effective commencing October 22, 2014:
  - a) Aggregate Type PB, Grade 4, LRA (Limestone Rock Asphalt) previous cost per ton \$38.50; new cost \$41.30.
3. All other provisions of Agreement shall remain the same.

Martin Marietta is requesting a \$2.80 per ton increase on both contracts listed above due to the following increases in costs supplying the product. MMM received a 6.5% rail increase July 1<sup>st</sup>, 5% increase on August 13<sup>th</sup> for truck freight to Nueces County stockpile location and MMM's raw materials, labor and other costs have increased 5%. 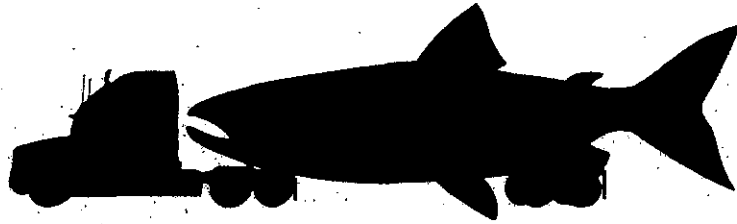
# UPRR 14 & UPRR 149

## July 1, 2014 Price Adjustments

- Union Pacific continues to invest heavily in its rail network, in order to provide reliable and efficient service to our customers. We spent approximately \$3.6 billion in 2013 and plan to increase our investment in 2014 to \$3.9 billion. In order to generate an acceptable level of return on our investments for maintenance and expansion of our extensive infrastructure, we must review and adjust our transportation rates accordingly. These rates will be published at market levels, with all rates subject to Union Pacific's carload mileage fuel surcharge provision. We are providing our customers with advance notice, so they can plan for these adjustments.
- Effective July 1, 2014, Union Pacific is announcing price adjustments in UPRR 14 and UPRR 149 for Aggregate business. Rate increases will vary by each market but will average three to six percent. Below is a summary of increases by market. Official publications can be referenced and downloaded through MyUPRR.com.
