AGREEMENT AMENDMENT NO. 2 – MEAL CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the Nueces County Juvenile Justice Center and Aramark Correctional Services, LLC, entered into an Agreement effective January 16, 2013 for meal services (RFP No. 2919-12 – Contract No. 20130049) for the pre- and post-adjudication facilities.

WHEREAS, the parties move to exercise the option set out in the Agreement to extend the term of the Agreement;


NOW, THEREFORE, Nueces County Juvenile Justice Center and Aramark Correctional Services, LLC, in consideration of the mutual agreements contained in the original Agreement providing for a contract renewal term do hereby mutually agree:


1. To change terminating date of effective contract from **January 15th** to be **January 31st**.
2. To exercise the renewal option for one (1) year and may be renewed by mutual agreement for four (4) additional one (1) year periods. This extension is the second (2nd) of the four (4) additional one (1) year period to begin **January 16, 2015** and terminate **January 31, 2016**.
3. It is agreed Aramark provided Nueces County Juvenile Justice Center written notice before June 1st, 2014 to request a CPI increase effective **January 16, 2015** based on 2013 Yearly Percentage Consumer Price Index (CPI) at 2%.
4. It is agreed the current rate per meal of **\$3.897** will increase to **\$3.975** per meal based on the CPI increase of 2% effective **January 16, 2015**.
5. All other provisions of Agreement shall remain the same.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto, intending to be legally bound, have duly executed this Amendment in duplicate.
