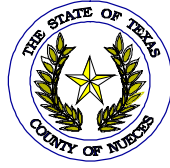

## COMMISSIONERS COURT RESOLUTION (HELP HITS THE HIGH NOTES – October 19, 2016)

**WHEREAS**, Hammons Education Leadership Programs (HELP), is a local 501 (c)(3) nonprofit that has, over the last eight years, taken almost 3,500 students and adults on over 250 separate visits to at least 120 job sites in the Coastal Bend to "help" them find the job of their dreams; and that of the many students who have participated in HELP On Site Career Mentoring ventures, 94% have either returned to or are still in school or advanced training, or have acquired meaningful employment; and,

**WHEREAS**, HELP has, through its various Career Clubs in the schools, provided exciting speakers and important virtual tours and demonstrations from a wide variety of in-demand and well-paying local careers; and,

**WHEREAS**, throughout the years, and with the assistance of Best Buy, Grande Communications, Kiwanis and others, HELP has installed \$60,000 worth of state-of-the-art touch screen "Windows On the World" in 12 Coastal Bend schools; and,

**WHEREAS**, HELP has recently installed a Window on the World at Veterans Memorial High School, creating a network of all 7 Corpus Christi Independent School District high schools to HELP the District fulfill the requirements of House Bill 5; and,

**WHEREAS**, HELP is holding its annual fundraiser at Brewster Street Ice House in downtown Corpus Christi featuring local celebrity talent on Wednesday, October 19, 2016;
