International show to feature local man

Local muralist Jeremy Flores will be a featured artist, representing the U.S. and Corpus Christi, at the International San Francisco Meeting of Styles 2016, officials said.

According to a news release, Flores was selected from thousands of submissions for "his artistic expertise, experience, passion for art education and professional and respectful character."

He will be one of six selected artists to be showcased in a fine art exhibit from Sept. 12-18 at the Mission Cultural Center for Latino Arts, the release states.

The International San Francisco Meeting of Styles is hosted by Mission Art 415. It's the world's largest international outdoor street art awareness and education event, officials said. The event covers about 24 city blocks in the Mission District of San Francisco.

Flores has recently worked on murals for local business including Costa Sur Wok and Ceviche Bar, So Blendy Barbershop, Munchies Bus food truck. Flores plans

to work with the Marina Arts District and begin an art workshop for children and youth.

"My mission is to change the standard of success in our community by showing our youth things like this are possible," Flores said about the San Francisco event. "I will bring all of this love back to our city."
