Salaries: \$1,500 (divided evenly among our Therapist and Family Advocate)

During the period, October 1, 2015 to September 30, 2016, the Children's Advocacy Center of the Coastal Bend forensically interviewed 1,444 children who were reportedly victims of sexual abuse, severe physical abuse, witness to a violent crime, witness to domestic violence, or were drug endangered. The CACCB provided over 12,000 services to these children and their non-offending family members in an effort to help reduce the trauma and equip them with services to aid in the healing process.

Our goal at the Children's Advocacy Center of the Coastal Bend is to continue to advocate for the rights of children and their specific needs, as well as create an environment where child abuse is no longer tolerated. Training: \$ 1513.32
