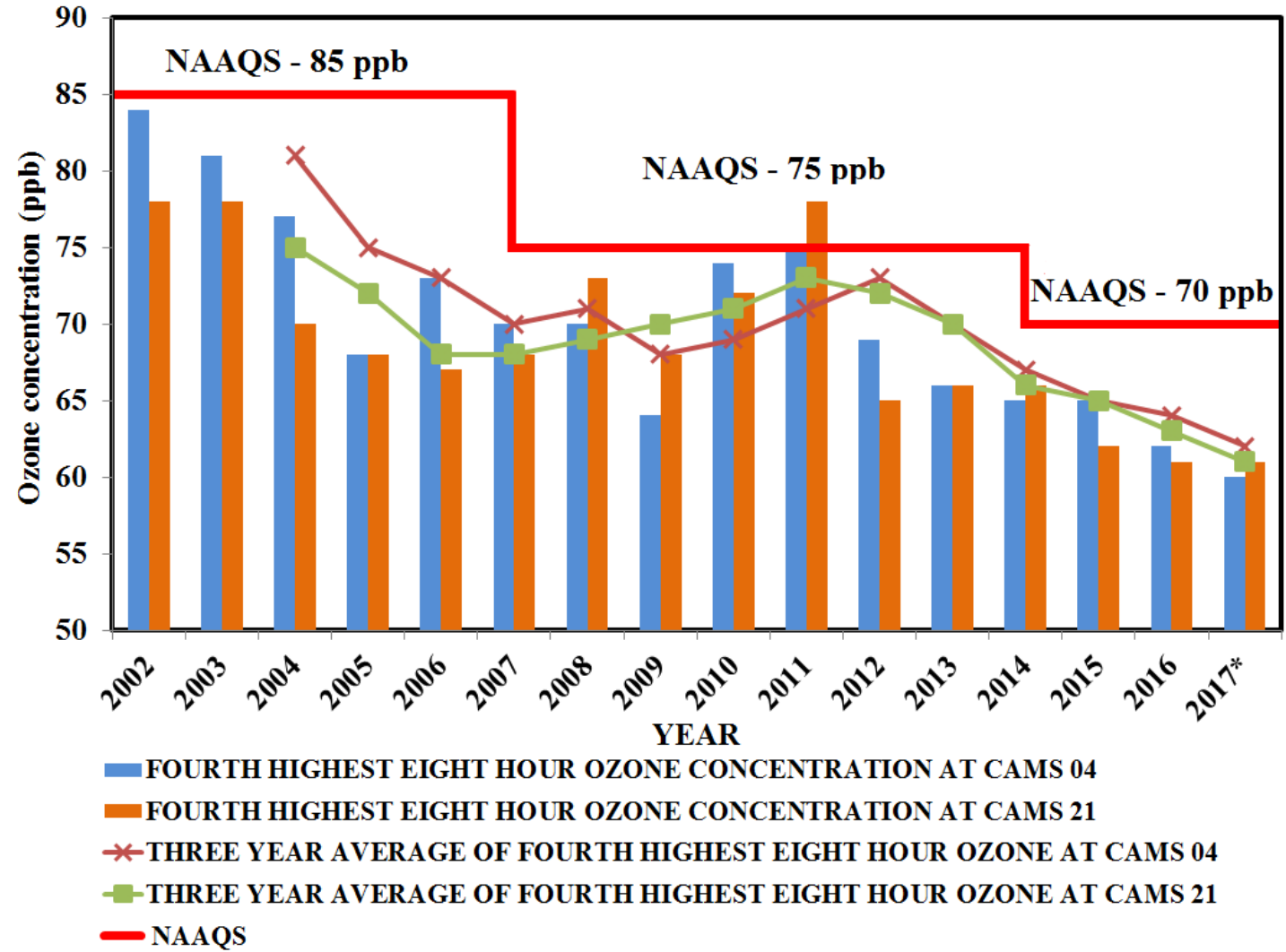
CORPUS CHRISTI REMAINS IN ATTAINMENT OF OZONE STANDARDS

- 70 Parts per Billion (ppb) announced by the U S EPA in 2015.
- November 6, 2017 U S EPA announced Corpus Christi in attainment of the 2015 new standards for ozone.

CORPUS CHRISTI COMPLIANCE WITH OZONE STANDARDS MOVING FORWARD

- CAMS 4 and CAMS 21 must experience a 4th high ozone level of less than 85 parts per billion in 2018 to remain in compliance with ozone standards at year-end 2018.
- Funding of local air quality programs efforts continue
 - Resolutions

 - Comment on application of \$209 million coming to Texas/TCEQ for air emissions reductions programs from VW suit.
