On behalf of the LEAD First Program and Superior Health Plan, I would like to give a report on the 11<sup>th</sup> Annual LEAD First Back to School Education and Diabetes Fair. The event was held on Saturday, August 19<sup>th</sup>, 2017 from 10:00 a.m. till 2:00 p.m., at Miller High School. We would like to thank the Commissioners for their support and efforts to educate and promote healthy life styles for persons living with Diabetes. There were over 5,300 participants for the event. We gave away free 200 immunizations, 2,020 vision testing, 1,300 hearing testing 2,300 Diabetes screening and testing and 350 physicals. The \$3,000 received from Nueces County Commissioners was for free shots, Diabetes screening, food, printing, facilities cost, and free Physicals. Thanks County Commissioners again, for your support, to help meet these great needs throughout our city and surrounding communities.

The LEAD First Back to School Education and Diabetes Fair is a community event designed to improve all aspects of the quality of life in the City of Corpus Christi including health care, community policing and economic development. The Fair include Health screening, Diabetes screening, diabetes education and information on healthy living, **entertainment, games, refreshments and information booths** for all community residents. There were numerous organizations present to let the community know about services and upcoming events that they are planning and gave their staff a chance to meet the local residents and join in the community celebration. The LEAD First Back to School Education and Diabetes Fair had hosted 4 coordination meetings on July 25<sup>th</sup>, August 1<sup>st</sup>, August 8<sup>th</sup> at 1:30 p.m. These meetings were held at Solomon Coles High School in our Library @ 924 Winnebago Street. The final meeting was held on Friday, August 18<sup>th</sup>, 2017 at 9:30 am @ Miller High School in the GYM. This meeting will consist of setting up and packing backpacks, any extra volunteers will greatly be appreciated.
