AGREEMENT

Nueces County and Corpus Christi Fraternal Order of Police-Lodge #27

This agreement entered into on the date set forth below by and between Nueces County, hereinafter called "County," and Corpus Christi Fraternal Order of Police-Lodge #27 hereinafter called "Corpus Christi FOP," a National Organization of Police Officers that offers community involvement for needy children in Nueces County.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Commissioners Court finds that there is a need for programs to provide services to and support of children in need of protection and care; and

WHEREAS, Corpus Christi FOP provides needy children with clothes through an annual Shop with a Cop Christmas program; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court is authorized to provide for services to and support of children in need of protection and care without regard to the immigration status of the child or the child's family pursuant to § 264.006 of the Texas Family Code and the determination of Texas Attorney General Opinion No. JC-0439 (2001);

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration and exchange of mutual covenants and conditions contained herein to provide services to and support of children in need of protection and care, the County and Corpus Christi FOP agree as follows:

- I. Corpus Christi FOP will provide Shop with a Cop by having its members team up with needy children of Nueces County to take them shopping for clothes. Corpus Christi FOP will provide program access or remove barriers to accessibility under the Americans with Disabilities Act to allow individuals with disabilities the opportunity to participate and receive benefits of services, programs and activities.
- II. Corpus Christi FOP will submit a written report to the County indicating Corpus Christi FOP's performance of its obligations pursuant to this agreement. Corpus Christi FOP shall include in its report a detailed accounting of expenditures of County funds. Such

report should be presented to the County Commissioners' Court at a noticed meeting.

- III. As payment for these services to be rendered in the County's fiscal year 2017-2018, the County will provide \$2,500.00 subject to appropriations, for the continuation of Corpus Christi FOP's Shop with a Cop activities pursuant to the 2017-2018 County budget.
- IV. Corpus Christi FOP will cause this funding to be segregated from other funds used for activities of Corpus Christi FOP unrelated to the purposes of this agreement.
- V. This agreement shall continue in force and effect until December 31, 2018. In the event Corpus Christi FOP terminates its activities prior to the expiration of this agreement, the balance of any remaining funds shall be returned to the County in the same proportion that County funds bear to the total funds received or in the possession by Corpus Christi FOP to conduct activities related to this agreement.
