



CJD Family Violence Court Technology Improvement Grant Agreement

Project Overview

The Texas Council on Family Violence (TCFV), long recognized as an expert in justice system response to family violence, received grant funding from the Office of the Governor - Criminal Justice Division (CJD) to support communities' purchase of court technology equipment that will enhance the efficiency and operations of courtrooms that address domestic violence legal issues.

Texas Council on Family Violence (TCFV) agrees to support Texas' 214th District Court (herein "Grantee") as set forth below.

The Project

TCFV will:

1. Purchase approved items on or before August 31, 2018, and arrange to have them mailed or delivered to Grantee, using the following contact information provided by Grantee:

If an approved item is no longer available or is not available within the approved budget, TCFV will immediately notify Grantee, whereupon Grantee will immediately submit to TCFV a detailed request for a similar alternate item. TCFV will purchase any approved substitute items.

2. Communicate and provide support on a regular and as needed basis with Grantee regarding grant activities.
3. Submit timely grant reports to CJD.

Grantee will:

1. Provide TCFV with written notification upon receipt of the items purchased in accordance with this grant.
2. Grantee will notify TCFV immediately of any missing or defective items.
3. Submit the mandatory evaluative survey to TCFV by August 31, 2018.
4. Communicate on a regular and as needed basis with TCFV regarding grant activities.
5. Utilize financial and management controls that meet typical government grant requirements.
6. Obtain approval and coordinate with TCFV before participating with any media events related to grant project.

Key Dates

- July 10, 2018: Information and interest forms sent to courts
- July 23, 2018: Interest forms due to TCFV
- August 6, 2018:
 - Applicants will be notified by TCFV whether they will receive an award, the amount of award, and for what items the award may be used.
 - As a part of this award, TCFV will send successful applicants a short evaluative survey, on which they will explain how the funding met an important need and the positive impact on the courts and their communities. Completion of this survey is mandatory.
- August 31, 2018: All funds must be expended by applicants, and receipts received by TCFV (if requesting reimbursement) or items purchased by TCFV, to be shipped to applicant (if so requesting)
- September 7, 2018: Applicants must submit evaluative survey to TCFV
- September 21, 2018: Deadline for applicant reimbursement
