The CCPOA would like to thank Nueces County for the support given the Corpus Christi Police Officers' Association from the 2018-2019 County budget in the agreement for services rendered to support children in need of protection and care.

This year, as in past years, the Association focused specifically on our youth in programs such as our Boxing Gym where we assist at-risk youth learn new skills, teach them self-respect and discipline, along with providing them with nutritionally-sound meals, snacks, and beverages to assist them in keeping focused on their goals. Funds were also contributed to agencies such as: Special Olympics of Texas - whose mission is to change attitudes toward children with intellectual disabilities and to transform their lives through the joy of sport, Foster Angels of South Texas - the non-profit organization whose sole purpose is to enrich the lives of children in foster care, and CCPAL - for functions involving underprivileged youth of all ages i.e., fishing tournament, early college programs for lower income families, and "Operation Safe Return" (giving children the opportunity to receive necessary school supplies, obtain valuable safety information and ensure a healthy start to the upcoming school year). We continue to be so proud of our "Blue Santa" program that provides Christmas toys to La Armada and Boys & Girls Club underprivileged children for the holiday season, which continues to bring joy to our community youth and remains a very successful program. We also have provided funds as sponsorships to underprivileged students and additionally provided funds to an organization for the holiday season in making Christmas a little brighter for underprivileged children in our community by providing several hundred gifts to over 200 children that otherwise would not have excitement or thrill of opening a gift Christmas morning.

In closing, the funds provided to us by Nueces County were spent to purchase soft drinks, bottled water, nutritious snacks/food, as well as holiday presents for the youth of our community and will continue to do so with similar expenditures from Nueces County's generous donation.

On behalf of the CCPOA's Executive Board, once again many thanks to Nueces County in their efforts providing the citizens of Corpus Christi and Nueces County the best possible service.
