

CONTRACT

(NUECES COUNTY; The Purple Door)

STATE OF TEXAS

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

COUNTY OF NUECES

This agreement entered into on the date of its execution as set forth below by and between Nueces County, hereinafter called "County," and The Purple Door, (Purple Door), an organization for the provision of shelter, food, counseling, and support for women and their children who are victims of family violence as well as sexual assault.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court finds that there is a need for programs to provide services to and support of children in need of protection and care; and

WHEREAS, the Purple Door has developed services designed to provide women and their children with emergency shelter, food, counseling, and support; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court is authorized to provide for services to and support of children in need of protection and care without regard to the immigration status of the child

or the child's family pursuant to § 264.006 of the Texas Family Code and the determination of Texas Attorney General Opinion No. JC-0439 (2001);

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration and exchange of mutual covenants and conditions contained herein to provide services to and support of children in need of protection and care, the County and the Purple Door agree as follows:

I.

The Purple Door will provide women and their children who are victims of family violence with emergency shelter, food, counseling, and support within Nueces County. The Purple Door will provide program access or remove barriers to accessibility under the Americans with Disabilities Act to allow individuals with disabilities the opportunity to participate and receive benefits of services, programs and activities.

II.

The Purple Door will submit semi-annual reports to the County indicating activities by the Purple Door in performance of its obligations pursuant to this agreement. The Purple Door shall include in its reports a detailed accounting of expenditures of County funds and any measurable results obtained with regard to the effect of the emergency shelter, food, counseling, and support services provided for the children who are the victims

of family violence in Nueces County. Such reports shall be presented to the County Commissioners Court at a noticed meeting.

III.

The Purple Door will diligently use its resources to provide the aforementioned services designed to help and support the children who are the victims of family violence in Nueces County.

IV.

As payment for these services to be rendered in the County's fiscal year 2019-2020, the County will provide \$2,000 subject to appropriations for the administration of the Purple Door services pursuant to the 2019-2020 County Budget.

V.

The Purple Door will cause this funding to be segregated from other funds used for the services of the Purple Door unrelated to the purposes of this agreement.

VI.

This agreement shall continue in force and effect until September 30, 2020. In the event the Purple Door terminates its services related to the purposes of this agreement prior to the expiration of this agreement, the balance of any remaining funds shall be returned to the County in the same proportion that County

funds bear to the total funds received or in the possession by the Purple Door to conduct services related to this agreement.
