

NUECES COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT

RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO CONTRIBUTE RIGHT OF WAY FUNDS (FIXED PRICE) FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO SH 286 FOR RIGHT OF WAY ACQUISITION AND ADJUSTMENT OF UTILITIES FROM FM 43 TO SOUTH OF FM 2444.

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation (TXDOT) is responsible for the design, construction, and operation of a system of highways in cooperation with local governments;

WHEREAS, TXDOT has plans to make improvements to SH 286 from FM 43 to South of FM 2444 and has requested the County contribute right of way funds to assist with those improvements; and

WHEREAS, the right of way funds will be used to acquire right of way and to relocate and make adjustments to utilities for the proposed improvements as noted above; and

WHEREAS, the total estimated cost needed for the above-stated purposes is \$3,105,725.00. Of which TXDOT has proposed the County contribute \$223,612.00; and

WHEREAS, the County of Nueces must pass a resolution authorizing the County to enter into the Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation to Contribute Right of Way Funds (Fixed Price); and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioner Court of the County of Nueces, Texas:

THAT the Commissioners Court authorizes the County Judge to execute the Agreement to Contribute Right of Way Funds (Fixed Price) with the Texas Department of Transportation for acquisition of certain right of way and there locating and adjusting of utilities due to certain highway improvements for SH 286 from FM 43 to South of FM 2444, as per the agreement attached hereto.

THAT the County Judge, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to act on the County's behalf in all matters pertaining to this contract.

THAT this resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
