

I.

CBWF will continue its youth and family prevention program, Project Turnaround, to provide education services to adolescents who are at risk for substance abuse and participate in other risky behaviors and their families within Nueces County.

II.

CBWF will submit semi-annual reports to the County indicating activities by CBWF in performance of its obligations pursuant to this agreement. CBWF shall include in its reports a detailed accounting of expenditures of County funds and any measurable results obtained with regard to its Project Turnaround program in Nueces County. Such reports shall be presented to the County Commissioners Court at a noticed meeting.

III.

CBWF will diligently use its resources to provide the aforementioned services to citizens of Nueces County.

IV.

As payment for accrued and future services to be rendered in the County's fiscal year 2019-2020, the County will provide \$1,000 subject to appropriations for the administration of CBWF activities pursuant to the 2019-2020 County Budget.

V.

CBWF will cause this funding to be segregated from other funds used for activities of CBWF unrelated to the purposes of this agreement.

VI.

This agreement shall continue in force and effect until September 30, 2020. In the event

CBWF terminates its activities related to the purposes of this agreement prior to the expiration of this agreement, the balance of any remaining funds shall be returned to the County in the same proportion that County funds bear to the total funds received or in the possession by CBWF to conduct activities related to this agreement.
