- Grant from County assists in meeting the required match to maintain contracts providing funding for indigent care.
 - Total HHSC contract \$3,160,464
 - Required match \$158,023
 - Nueces County--\$22,500 or 14% of required local cash match
 - Financial statement provided separately
- Services provided under these contracts
 - Detoxification
 - Ambulatory Detox
 - Intensive inpatient
 - Supportive inpatient
 - Specialized services for women with children
 - Co-occurring psychiatric and substance use disorder treatment
 - Recovery Support services

Demographic Highlights

- Youngest 19, oldest 76
- Largest age group 35-44 (33%)
- 22% under age 30
- 30% increase in amphetamine users
- 42 % decrease in “other” users, primarily synthetic

- Applied for 100 additional bed expansion
- Network of facilities across the state, including Amarillo for faster access to services
- Broader insurance network participation
- Serving on the Nueces County Opioid Task Force
