

**ADDENDUM TO CITY/COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT
CENTER INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT**

This Addendum is made and entered into by and between the City of Port Aransas, Texas, a Texas home rule municipality, herein referred to as "City" and Nueces County, Texas, a political subdivision of the State of Texas, herein referred to as "County", both of which are governmental entities as defined under Section 791.003(4) Texas Government Code.

The parties hereto, City and County, made and entered into that one certain City/County Law Enforcement Center Interlocal Agreement executed by the City on April 18, 1994 and by the County on March 16, 1994, which agreement is still in effect. The Law Enforcement Center building which is the subject of the agreement was destroyed by Hurricane Harvey. The City is in the process of securing the funds necessary to rebuild the building.

This Addendum is necessary to facilitate the City acquisition of such funds and construction of a new Law Enforcement Center.

The parties agree as follows:

The City has the final determination on the scope of work, building materials and payment authorizations. Material selections will be made in conjunction with the County and will be placed into the bid issued by the City. Contract, bid, and change orders will all be managed by the City.

Any remaining insurance proceeds that remain for this facility will be turned over to the City of Port Aransas to offset the final construction price as required by FEMA.
