**NOTICE OF PENDING APPOINTMENTS TO THE
NUECES COUNTY ANIMAL CONTROL ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Nueces County Commissioners Court will consider (3) three appointments to the Board of Directors of the Nueces County Animal Control Advisory Committee. (2) two appointments are for members and (1) one is for a Licensed Veterinarian.

This committee was established in 1988 to adhere to State Law, Chapter 823 of the Texas Health and Human Services Code.

MEMBER REQUIREMENTS: By statute, the committee must be composed of at least: one (1) licensed veterinarian, one (1) county or municipal official, one (1) person whose duties include the daily operation of an animal shelter, and one (1) representative from an animal welfare organization.

Applicants must have been a resident of Nueces County for at least one year; not convicted of a felony or misdemeanor crime of moral turpitude for which he/she has not been pardoned in the last ten (10) years; and has not been removed from a board or commission because of failure to attend meetings within the last three (3) years.

TERM: Two year staggered terms.
