NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Nueces County Commissioners Court is considering two (2) appointments, (Place 1 and Place 2) for the terms ending December 31, 2020.

This Board was created in 1922 by Section 62.021 et.seq., as authorized by Article XVI, Section 59, of the Texas Constitution. The Board's responsibility is to encourage industrial expansion, attracting new cargo, building and maintaining public terminals, setting operating policy, and cooperating with the Federal Government as local sponsor in maintaining and improving vital navigation channels.

The Board of Commissioners is composed of seven members. Three commissioners are appointed by the Corpus Christi City Council, three are appointed by the Nueces County Commissioners Court, and one is appointed by the San Patricio County Commissioners Court. Board members serve three year terms.

Interested and qualified citizens of Nueces County are invited to submit a board application with attached resume of qualifications. **Incumbents need only to submit a letter of interest.
