

NUECES COUNTY INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION

DUTIES:

Investigate and undertake ways of promoting the prosperous development of business, industry and commerce in the county. The commission shall promote the location and development of new businesses and industries in the county and the maintenance and expansion of existing businesses.

COMPOSITION:

The commission must consist of not less than seven persons who must be residents of the county and must have exhibited interest in the industrial development of the county. Board members shall serve for a term of two (2) years and may serve more than one (1) term. Vacancies, as they occur, shall be filled by appointment of County Judge.

CREATION & AUTHORITY:

Board to have and exercise such lawful authority and duties conferred upon it by Chapter 381 of TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE.

MEETS: Virtually on the first Tuesday of every month from 11:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

TERMS: Two (2) year terms.
