We firmly believe as the private sector investment in Port Aransas continues to grow, it will become vital that we maintain our government owned parcels of land and property to ensure we are able to support the livability and quality of life for our residents and visiting public.

In the coming year, the City of Port Aransas will be conducting several planning efforts, including a city-wide comprehensive plan. While this property is not owned by the city, the county does own this and its location can prove invaluable to our sustainable future, especially in our main street thoroughfare and in the heart of our Old Town district.

With the abovementioned concerns, we respectfully request that Nueces County consider postponing and reevaluating the sale of this property to support the critical protection of our city until a thorough review of planning and needs for this area can be conducted.
