COMMISSIONERS COURT RESOLUTION

“RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF HB 2210/ SB 780 REGARDING INTERGOVERNMENTAL SUPPORT AGREEMENTS IN THE 87th TEXAS LEGISLATURE”

WHEREAS, House Bill 2210/ Senate Bill 780 would authorize local governments to enter into intergovernmental support agreements with a branch of the armed forces of the United States; and

WHEREAS, Intergovernmental Support Agreements (IGSA) are provided for under federal authority allowing Department of Defense (DoD) installations to enter into agreements with state and local government entities for the acquisition of goods and services; and

WHEREAS, an IGSA can lower the cost of doing business and create efficiencies for DoD while producing new efficiencies and revenue for state and local partners; and

WHEREAS, IGSA's produce local jobs, keeping federal funds in Texas, supporting local small business, and creating new revenue for local government at a time when such revenue is sorely needed; and

WHEREAS, IGSA's can lower the cost of doing business for the military in Texas, making the state more competitive for new missions and federal job growth, as well as making bases safer from Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) if one occurs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF NUECES COUNTY, that it strongly supports House Bill 2210/ Senate Bill 780 authorizing local governments to enter into intergovernmental support agreements with a military unit of the United States Department of Defense assigned to a military installation located within the boundaries of Texas.
