

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration and exchange of mutual covenants and conditions contained herein, the County and the Purple Door agree as follows:

I.

The Purple Door will continue to provide family violence prevention, intervention, and counseling to families that have experienced family violence. The Purple Door will provide women and their children who are victims of family violence with emergency shelter, food, counseling, and support within Nueces County. The Purple Door will provide program access or remove barriers to accessibility under the Americans with Disabilities Act to allow individuals with disabilities the opportunity to participate and receive benefits of services, programs and activities.

II.

The Purple Door will semi-annually submit reports to the County indicating activities by the Purple Door in performance of its obligations pursuant to this agreement. The Purple Door shall include in its reports a detailed accounting of expenditures of County funds. Such reports shall be presented to the County Commissioners Court at a noticed meeting.

III.

The Purple Door will diligently use its resources to provide the services listed in I. above.

IV.

As payment for these services to be rendered in the County's fiscal year 2020-2021, the County will provide \$5,000.00 from the family protection fees collected, subject to the collection of such fees in that amount, for the continuation of activities of the Purple Door pursuant to the 2020-2021 County Budget.

V.

The Purple Door will cause this funding to be segregated from other funds used for activities of The Purple Door unrelated to the purposes of this agreement.

VI.

This agreement shall continue in force and effect until September 30, 2021. In the event the Purple Door terminates its activities prior to the expiration of this agreement, the balance of any remaining funds shall be returned to the County in the same proportion that County funds bear to the total funds received or in the possession by the Purple Door to conduct activities related to this agreement.

I, Frances Wilson (Person name), the undersigned

verify that the company named-above, under the provisions of Subtitle F, Title 10,

Government Code Chapter 2270:

2. Will not boycott Israel during the term of the contract.

Pursuant to Section 2270.001, Texas Government Code:

1. "Boycott Israel" means refusing to deal with, terminating business activities with, or otherwise taking any action that is intended to penalize, inflict economic harm on, or limit commercial relations specifically with Israel, or with a person or entity doing business in Israel or in an Israeli-controlled territory, but does not include an action made for ordinary business purposes; and
2. "Company" means a for-profit sole proprietorship, organization, association, corporation, partnership, joint venture, limited partnership, limited liability partnership, or any limited liability company, including a wholly owned subsidiary, majority-owned subsidiary, parent company or affiliate of those entities or business associations that exist to make a profit.
