**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A HEALTH SERVICES AND PLUMBING INSPECTION SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH FRANKLIN COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH FOR 2022**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 3709 of the Ohio Revised Code states that a city constitutes a health district and must provide health services for residents within that district; and

**WHEREAS**, Franklin County Public Health is requesting a two percent (2%) increase per capita; and

**WHEREAS**, the annual cost will not exceed Two Hundred Fifteen Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Four Dollars and Seventy Two Cents (\$215,254.72); and

**WHEREAS**, Pickerington City Council finds it to be in the best interest, health, safety, and welfare of the City to enter into an agreement for health services and plumbing inspection service with Franklin County Public Health for 2022, which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PICKERINGTON, FAIRFIELD-FRANKLIN COUNTIES, OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:**

**Section 1.** The Pickerington City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into an agreement for health services and plumbing inspection services with Franklin County Public Health for 2022 in substantially the same form as the attached Exhibit "A."

**Section 2.** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from the earliest date permitted by law.
